- Be a minimum of 18 years of age on or before October 25, 2010;
- Not be a candidate, or spouse of a candidate, running for office in the Township of Norwich;
- Attend a mandatory training session;
- Be prepared to arrive at your designated voting place at a specified time and remain there until after voting closes at 8:00 p.m. and all duties have been completed; and
- Return a completed application for employment and election exam
