



THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORWICH

BY-LAW NUMBER 20-2004

TO AUTHORIZE EXECUTION OF A SEVERANCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORWICH AND DIANNE ELIZABETH BARNIM

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001 as amended, Chapter 25, Section 5(3) states that “A municipal power, including a municipality’s capacity, rights, powers and privileges under section 8, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise”;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, as amended, Chapter 25, Section 8 states that “A municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act”;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to execute a Severance Agreement between The Corporation of The Township of Norwich and Dianne Elizabeth Barnim to facilitate a severance, File B-57/03;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of The Township of Norwich hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute on behalf of the municipality, a Severance Agreement between The Corporation of The Township of Norwich and Dianne Elizabeth Barnim, Part Lot 11, Concession 9 and designated as Part 2 on Plan 41R-7021 (formerly the Township of South Norwich), in the County of Oxford, for the purpose of facilitating a severance on the subject property in accordance with the Land Division decision File No. B-57/03, Condition No. 2, and 3, dated October 2, 2003.
2. That By-law 63-2002 be hereby repealed.
3. That this by-law shall be effective upon the passing thereof.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 23RD DAY OF MARCH 2004.
